Donation: The club donated 30 folders to Officer Cookie for the end of the year chess certificates on Saturday, June 30.

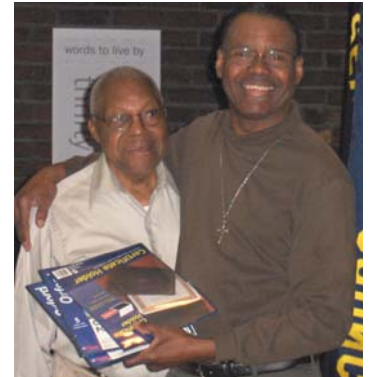
New Club Management System: Denis Sapiro & Karl Sutter are authorized to sign the club up for the management system at the International Convention if possible.
