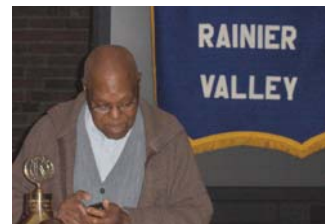

other groups. After Edison Technical he went to GM as a mechanic, trainer and in the management training program. He served as a instructor and dean at South Seattle Community College

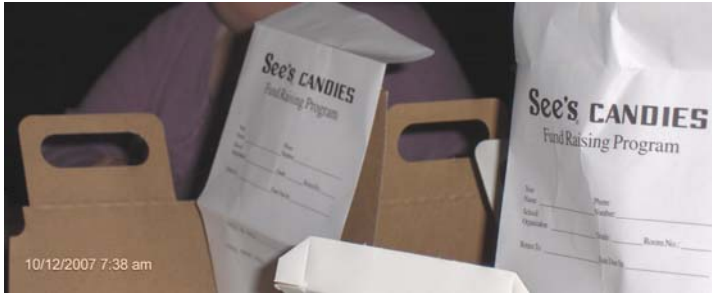
