Past Secretary Robert Thaxton were given a big THANK YOU and pins for their service. Past President Joseph was given a gift of a Kiwanis calculator and note pad.

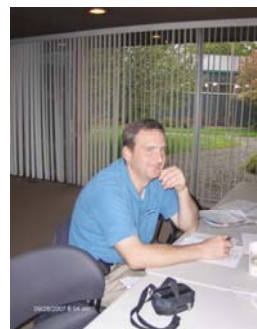
