At that time, just 16 months after the Detroit No. 1 club was chartered, there were a total of 16 clubs with 1,924 members. A Kiwanis International convention has been held every year since then, except for limited conferences in 1943-45 due to wartime travel restrictions. Today, the usual attendance at an International Convention is about 12,000. This year the convention will be in Orlando.
